Rehabilitation®

Upon admission to the rehabilitation unit, Carol required maximum assistance to roll or sit up in bed and could not stand or walk due to weakness and pain. She worked with physical therapy to improve leg strength and balance; occupational therapy to improve her performance in bathing, dressing, and bathroom use; and speech therapy to improve short-term memory and safety awareness. At the time of discharge home to her apartment, Carol was walking 500 feet with her walker and confidently performing daily activities.
